COMMENTS: There were corrections made to the pretrial services report by the defendant. The court considered the information as corrected and that the pretrial services report would be considered as evidence in the dention hearing. The court ordered that the pretrial services report be kept in the custody of probation office unless needed for review, it would be then filed under seal. The parties entered a stipulation that the other witnesses who would testify on behalf of Mr. Caton including his wife would be that his reputation in their area of lawful behavior and that he has made no threats or taken any violent or physical action against anyone. The court found that there is probable cause to believe that an offense has been committed as charged and that the defendant committed it and therefore that he be required to appear for further proceedings in connection with this charge. The court ordered that the defendant be detained pending the disposition of this charge.
